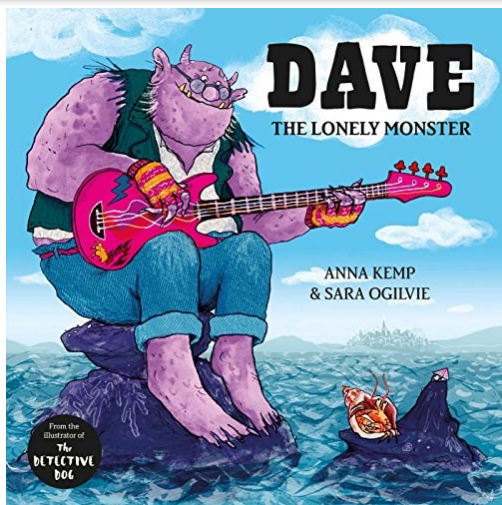

Science: Uses of Everyday Materials Subject Specific Vocabulary

Material	A material is any substance that has a name . For example: wood, metal, plastic, fabric, brick, rock, paper and cardboard.
Squash	Crush or squeeze (something) With force so that it becomes flat, soft, or out of shape. 
Bend	Shape or force (something straight) into a curve or angle. 
Twist	Bend, curl and move something in opposite directions. 
Stretch	Making something longer or wider without breaking.
